NSL Renewable Power Wins 'Best Operating Wind Farm' Award

Hyderabad: NSL Renewable Power Private Limited (NRPPL), part of the Hyderabad based NSL Group, won the 'Best Operating Wind Farm' award from Indian Wind Power Association (IWPA) for the third time. The award has been presented during the 3rd International Wind Conference and Exhibition at Coimbatore being organized by IWPA on 6th and 7th of February 2012. The 28 MW Jagalur Wind Farm which is located in Karnataka won this award for the years 2006-07, 2009-10 too.

Mr. Mandava Prabhakar Rao, Chairman, NSL Group, commented,

"It is a great pleasure to receive this award, which honors outstanding achievement in the Indian wind power sector and acts as recognition of exceptional contribution, innovation and excellence in the industry. Winning the award for the third time, demonstrates the efficiency of NSL Renewable Power in general and its wind power vertical in particular. This adds further to our vision of wind being on par with other renewable resources by acknowledging wind energy as efficient and competitive."

NRPPL has about 162 MW of installed capacity in renewable energy comprising of 150 MW of wind power and two bio-mass plants of 6 MW each. NRPPL is also constructing two medium scale hydro power projects (100 MW and 44 MW) and two small scale hydro power projects (5 MW and 6 MW) in Himachal Pradesh. Company's solar vertical is constructing a 20MW power project. In addition, NRPPL has multiple wind power projects under development totaling over 700 MW, which will be implemented over the next 2-3 years.

NSL Group is the promoter of Regen Powertech Private Limited, which is the fastest growing wind turbine manufacturer in the country.

About NSL Renewable Power Private Limited:

The objective of the company is to generate power from Renewable Energy Sources. The company has four divisions viz. Wind, Hydro, Biomass and Solar.
